Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Confirmation of full school opening in September

The advice provided to schools about safety measures is continually changing. The following information is in addition to the information received previously on 25th August and 15th July. You can find a copy of all three letters on the website.

- An update about the wearing of face masks has been released. It has now been advised that face masks are worn by all pupils and staff in Secondary schools in England in areas where Social Distancing is not possible (medical exemptions do apply). As Harrytown is in a local lockdown area it is now compulsory for all staff and pupils to wear face masks. Please make sure that your child comes to school with a face mask to be worn. It is likely that once in a classroom pupils can remove them to complete work but must wear them in the corridors and other communal areas of school.
- If you are dropping your child off at school or picking them up, please do not enter the school carpark. This is strictly for staff only. Please also park away from the school bus bays. At the start and end of the day this area is very busy and can be quite dangerous if we have vehicles blocking areas.
- As a reminder, if you need to speak to a member of staff please email school through the contact us form and the appropriate member of staff will get back to you as soon as is possible. We are unable to let visitors or unexpected visitors into the school building to comply with the COVID-19 Safety measures. If people do not have an appointment they will be turned away.

We are doing everything possible to make school a safe environment for pupils and staff and will continue to do so. Please stress to your child/children the importance of their role in adhering to these measures to help us keep school safe for them.

Thank you once again for your support and understanding throughout these very difficult and ever-changing circumstances. Any further changes will be communicated to you through letter/e-mail and the website. As a school we are eager for pupils to return and continue their education in the safest environment we can offer. Staff are looking forward to welcoming our pupils through the doors once again and we look forward to working with you in the future.
