### YEAR 11 ARRANGEMENTS FROM 04 JUNE 2018

We would like to inform you of the plans for the remainder of the examination period. It is now the case that a number of pupils have completed many of their examinations in a number of subjects and therefore are revising, independently for other subjects during these lessons, it would seem an appropriate time to offer the pupils the flexibility of being able to study at home and no longer being compulsorily required to attend school. In response to requests from both pupils and parents, we have decided to allow pupils the opportunity to study at home from **Monday 04 June 2018** should it be your wish that they do so.

During this period we will continue to operate a timetable for pupils who wish to attend sessions with their subject teacher. Pupils are free to attend lessons and revision sessions in accordance with the following guidelines:

- At all times – whether it be for examinations, extra lessons or revision sessions pupils must attend school in **full school uniform**.
- Pupils must **always** sign in and out at the main entrance when entering or leaving the site.
- Pupils who have both a morning and afternoon examination **must** stay on site throughout lunchtime
- Pupils must ensure that they are fully aware of when they are required to attend for **all examinations** and be here in plenty of time in advance of the start time.

I hope that these optional and flexible arrangements will allow all pupils to continue to prepare fully for their remaining examinations in a way that best suits them, and that you will continue to support us by ensuring that they prepare adequately for each examination session. Throughout this final stage of their time at Harrytown please consult the school website where all additional arrangements will be posted, but if you have any queries please contact either the Examinations Officer, the relevant Subject Leader or Mr Tickle (Head of Year 11).

Where a Subject Leader or class teacher feels that a compulsory revision session in school would benefit your child, they will contact you directly by text. Please ensure that your child attends these sessions.
